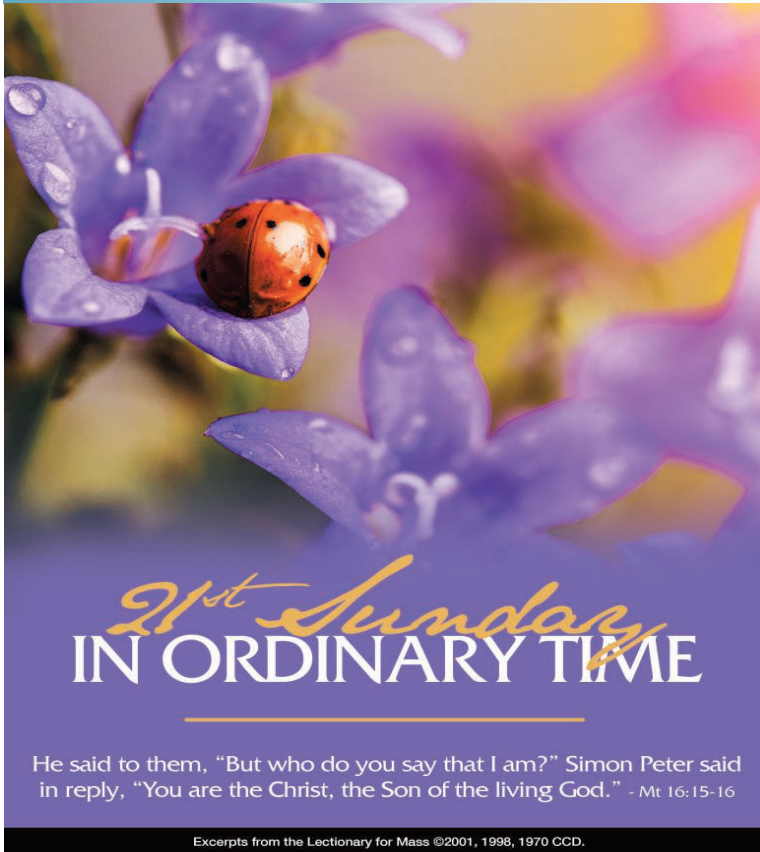

Your baby is growing rapidly this week. Just four weeks after conception and your baby is about 1/8th of an inch long. 40 pairs of muscles have developed along the trunk of this precious new life. Small buds will soon grow into arms and legs. The heart beats with a regular rhythm. Basic facial features will begin to appear; an opening for the mouth and passage-ways for the inner ear. Digestive and respiratory systems begin to form as well.
