

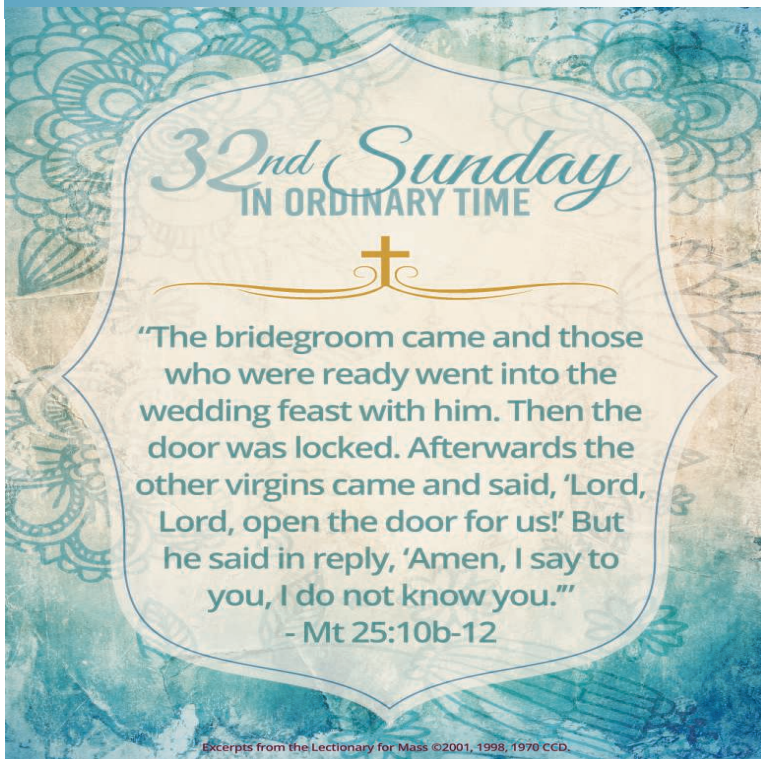

Spiritual Adoption—Week 15

Although baby has been moving and stretching for six whole weeks, finally mom might begin to feel her baby move. The first day that movement is noticed by the mother is called “quickening.” Baby has developed adult taste buds. Nutrients from the mother will reach your baby within 1-2 hours. 300 quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. The skin is pink and transparent.
