Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

This week in the church calendar is called Holy Week. It is a very important week in the liturgical year, as well as our spiritual lives.

There are a few times left for confessions. On Tuesday, Fr. Dean will be here to listen to confessions in case you would rather not go to the pastor.

All are invited to come to church on Wednesday, March 28 at 6:30 pm to listen to Brian Cole. He has a powerful message about how we need to make the right choices in our lives.

The entire mass schedule has changed because of Holy Week. Please keep the bulletin close by for easy reference. There is **NO** morning mass on Thursday, March 29. The Easter Triduum begins with Holy Thursday mass at 7:00 pm at St. Joseph. The Good Friday service will be at 12:00 noon at St. Joseph and 3:00 pm at St. Ann in Cable. There are **NO** Stations of the Cross that day. Saturday morning at 10:00 we will have the Blessing of Easter baskets at St. Joseph. There is **NO** 4:00 mass on Saturday, March 31 because the Easter Vigil demands that we begin in darkness. Therefore, the Easter Vigil begins at 8:00 pm. Please note that for our combined services on Thursday and Saturday we will have readers and ministers from both parishes involved to show our cluster unity and our willingness to work together. The Easter Sunday schedule remains the same as the usual Sunday schedule. I encourage you to make use of these unique and beautiful liturgical experiences.

Also, please note that the Divine Mercy Novena begins on Good Friday and ends on Divine Mercy Sunday. There will be an additional mass and devotions on Divine Mercy Sunday. Keep posted as to more details in next week's bulletin.

May your Holy Week be blessed.
