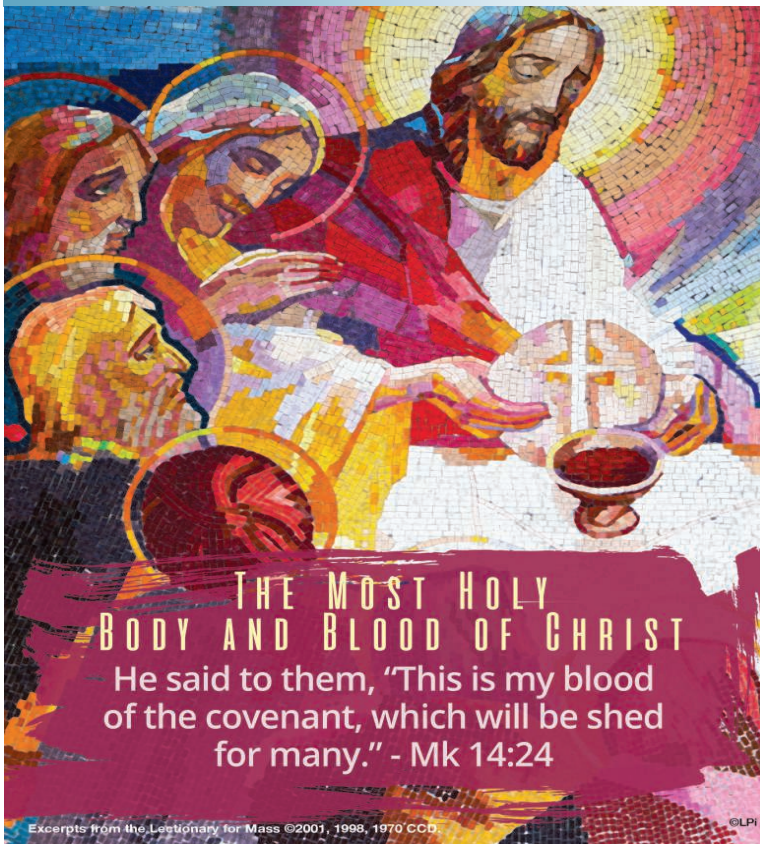

Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

This Sunday the church celebrates the Body & Blood of Jesus. Our Catholic faith professes that with valid matter, a validly ordained priest and the proper words and intentions at the mass, the bread and wine become the body and blood of Jesus. We are proud to profess that faith at each mass. There is a long tradition in the Catholic faith to have a procession on this Sunday to express our faith to the world. All are welcome and encouraged to take part in the “Corpus Christi” procession following the 10:15 mass (around 11:30) on Sunday June 3. Your presence is greatly appreciated.

This weekend the Knights of Columbus will hold their annual Tootsie Roll drive. All money collected goes toward Ventured Unlimited.

As I mentioned last week before the masses, St. Joseph Parish in Hayward is equipped with “the Loop.” It is to assist those who have hearing difficulties. A couple of things to keep in mind. It does not work in the blue overflow section. If you wear hearing aids, switch the device to T-coil mode. If you do not have hearing aids but still have problems hearing, you are encouraged to use a portable device with a headset. They are in the back of the church. Pick one up before mass and return it after the mass.

I want to share with you some great news about your generosity. Recently we received a rebate check for both parishes from the diocesan Faith in Our Future pledge campaign. St. Ann received two checks for a total amount of \$112.50. St. Joseph received two checks for a total amount of \$3228.40. Besides the money received from the Faith in Our Future, St. Joseph Parish received a check from the diocese for \$8,312.00. This was the amount over our CSA target goal. As you know, whatever money comes in over our goal comes back to the parish. Your generosity is truly a testimony to your commitment to the parish, diocese and your God. May God Bless you always.
