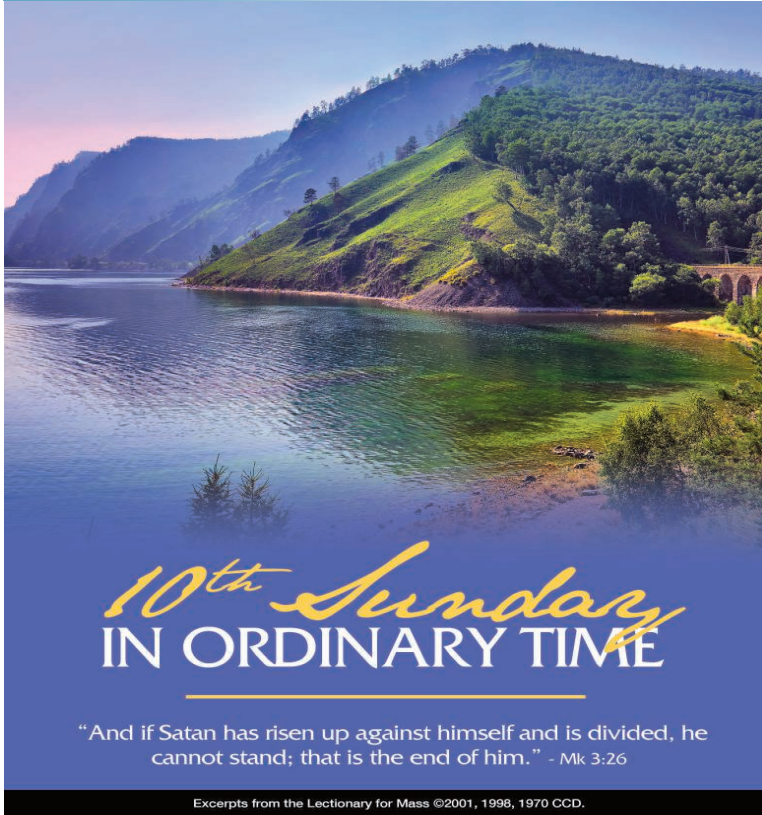

From the Desk of.....

Fr. Gerard

Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

I have used this space to correspond to parishioners and visitors alike about the happenings in our parish. I try to communicate as much as I can to be transparent, open and honest with the activities in the parish. This week's topic is no different.

For the past four months, the parish finance and pastoral councils have been in very serious discussions about the three properties across from the church. As you know, the three houses have been for sale for a number of years. This past year there has been more interest in purchasing these properties for a number of reasons—1) The proximity of the property; 2) The desire to control the area around us as much as we can control it; 3) The safety of our children during religious education classes and all who use our adoration chapel day or night; 4) To increase the value of our own property; 5) The possibility for future expansion or our own use.

The parish pastoral and finance council have worked very hard in the discussion, decisions and planning for the purchase of the three buildings. I want to thank both councils for their interest, foresight and commitment to St. Joseph Parish Community.

We have been in negotiations with the owners of the property. There has been an offer that is agreed upon by both parties. There are still some contingencies that are being worked through. All information and negotiations have been shared with our Bishop and the diocesan staff. All information has been in the minutes of the meetings and have been available for public reading. The Bishop has responded very favorably for St. Joseph Parish and the purchase of all three properties.

The properties (if all contingencies are met) will be paid for from the parish savings and what is in the checkbook. We had a company test the buildings for hazardous materials (asbestos, lead paint, etc.).

The buildings are in disrepair and need to be torn down. There are many ideas that have been suggested for its use; parking, green space, an area for children/youth activities, etc. Nothing has been decided at this time for the properties' future use.

We are looking out for the best interest of St. Joseph Parish and its future. Again, I want to thank all involved for their hard work, generosity and care for St. Joseph Parish. If you have further questions, please contact a parish council representative. May God Bless you always.
