From the Desk of.....

Fr. Gerard

Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

A number of ministers in the Hayward area gather twice per month. The group is called GHAMA (the Greater Hayward Area Ministerial Association). The first Wednesday of the month the ministers gather to pray for the Hayward community and beyond; the third Wednesday is the business meeting. I have been actively attending these meetings for the past 1-1/2 years. They have been very informative for me in learning more about the Hayward community. I have come to learn that the local ministers care deeply for their own congregations, as well as the entire area of Hayward.

For the past few months we have been having some serious discussions about the larger Hayward community. We held discussions at length about the biggest issue facing this area; alcohol and drugs (including meth). There are other topics we have discussed; housing, incarceration (jail), jobs, recovery, homelessness, etc.

Hayward is a wonderful area to live and belong. We all want the best for our community. GHAMA has discussed at length how we can help support people to alleviate some of the most pressing needs of the community. We know we need to work together with social service agencies, law enforcement, treatment centers and the like to effectively make positive steps toward change.

One idea that has been tossed around is the idea of temporary housing for someone who has no place to go after being released from jail or a treatment facility. GHAMA knows it takes time, money, resources and individuals to make this a reality.

I bring all of this to your attention to say: 1) The clergy has a love for the Hayward community; 2) We have been working together on a number of issues that affect the community; 3) If we want to make positive changes, we need the support of all of the churches to work together; 4) Down the road you may hear more about these issues and ask for your support.

If there are other needs of the community that we should be discussing, please feel free to bring it to our attention. Thank you all for all you do to make this community a great place to belong. May God Bless you always.
