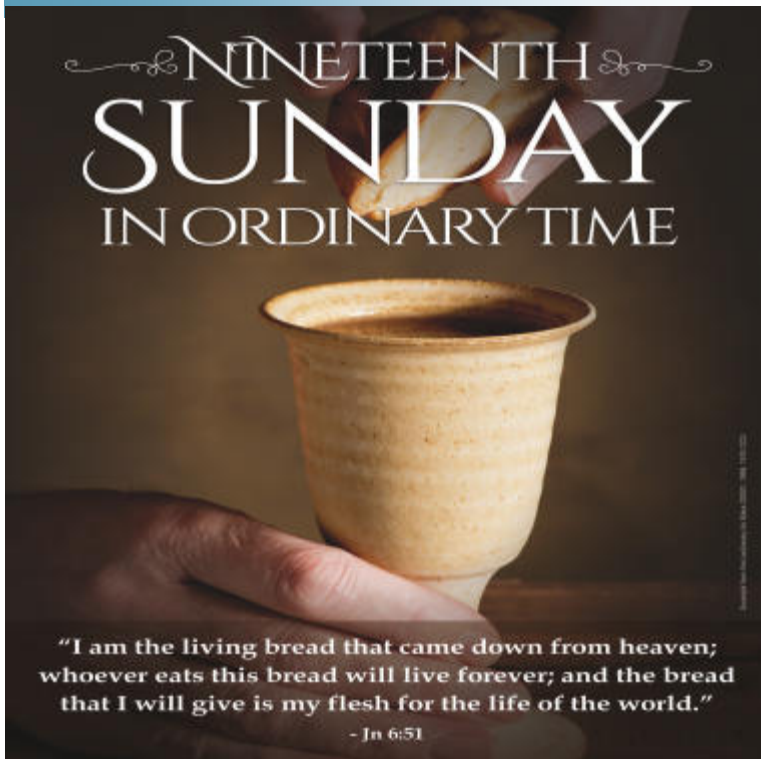

Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

This week the church celebrates the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This dogma of the Catholic Church states that the Blessed Virgin Mary was assumed into heaven. The Feast of the Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation for Catholics. On Holy Days, Catholics are obligated to attend mass. Please consult the bulletin for mass times. Please note that the regularly scheduled 5:15 Tuesday evening mass is an anticipatory Holy Day mass; so yes, it does count for the Holy Day.

Next weekend we begin the Catholic Services Appeal (CSA) pledge drive. We will be previewing a video from our Bishop. This is a diocesan pledge drive that happens every year. We are obligated to meet this goal. This year's goal for St. Joseph Parish is \$61,467 and for St. Ann Parish, the goal is \$15,327. If we do not meet this goal, we still have to pay for it out of our operating budget. As Catholics, we belong to a diocese. Besides the support of our local parish, we also support the diocese in which we belong. Thank you for your generosity toward this pledge drive.

I am humbled and grateful for the love and support you have given to me over the past three years. Your kindness has been noticed and will not be forgotten.
