

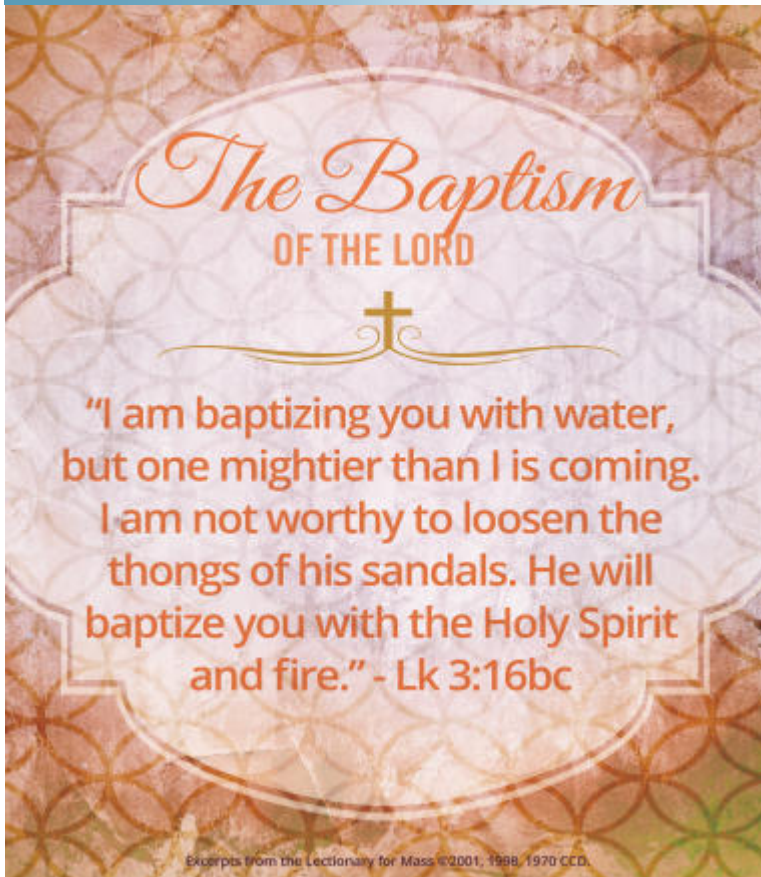

Dear parishioners, visitors, guests and benefactors—

This weekend at the 10:15 mass we will have the Rite of Enrollment for our second grade students who will be receiving their First Holy Communion. We will call up the children, acknowledge them, ask you to pray for them and then bless them.

This week and next weekend I will be away from the parishes. Fr. Dean will have the weekend masses in my absence. Please welcome Fr. Dean and thank him for being our priest for the weekend.

I will be on a bus heading to Washington, D.C. for the March for Life rally. I will be with other members from our parish. The Diocese of Superior is sending two buses from the diocese to the March for Life. I have been asked to go, pray daily mass, hear confessions and help with Eucharistic Adoration. Please pray for our safety out east and a safe return. I hope I will survive. I'm not looking forward to the 23-hour bus ride, but I was reminded that it is a pilgrimage.

As you know, Catholics are very pro-life. We support life from conception to natural death. So many in both of our parishes support pro-life issues. Thank you for the love that you continue to share.

St. Joseph, Hayward, is a very active and busy parish. It is a blessing to belong to a parish with such high involvement.
