MISSION TRIPS
CONNECTING TO GOD, EACH OTHER AND OUR COMMUNITY

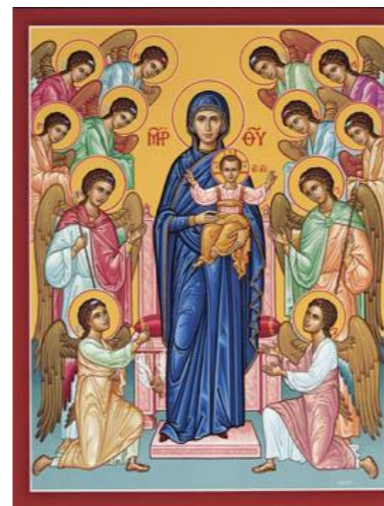
My personal experience with young people coming to the U.S. Mexico border has given me a special appreciation of what mission trips can be for young people. When I came here and learned of the past experience of mission trips to the Bush, I made connections in my mind. In my opinion, mission experiences do offer something important for young people in a time when being part of a Church community is so commonly called into question.

Being part of the Church really does have to mean doing – living out faith in practical ways through the practice of the corporal and spiritual works of mercy in church settings.

This past week, I went with three young adults from OLA to Tijuana, Mexico. A donor generously helped with the travel expenses of two of the four and the young people raised the rest of the funds for this trip on their own. Funding for this faith experience was not taken from parish funds.

We spent six days living in an OMI mission parish and taking part in parish activities, seeing and getting to know the realities of life in a very different setting from what we know here. This included taking part in parish activities, meeting young people whose reality is in many ways very different from ours, learning of works of mercy such as medical services offered at a parish clinic, an AIDS hospice and educational programs offered to the local community.

Language issues limit some of what we can do, but they will not keep us from entering into the life of the people in the part of Tijuana for a short time at least. The hoped for result will be to present an experience of Church that will broaden our young people's vision of what the Catholic Church is. ~ Fr. Tom, OMI
