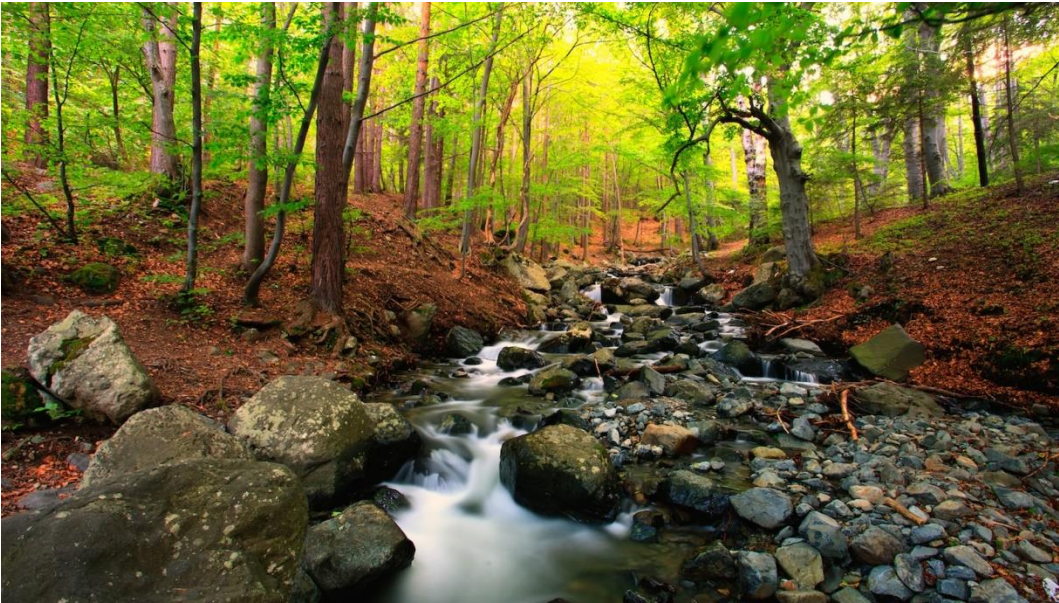

It is with deep regret that we announce today the decision of the Provincial Administration of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate to withdraw from the western side of the Kenai Peninsula as of July 1 of this year.
