### AUGUST: THE MONTH OF THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

---

The month of August is dedicated to the **Immaculate Heart**. Since the 16th century Catholic piety has assigned entire months to special devotions. The month of August is traditionally dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The physical heart of Mary is venerated (and not adored as the Sacred Heart of Jesus is) because it is united to her person and is the seat of her love (especially for her divine Son), virtue, and inner life. Such devotion is an incentive to a similar love and virtue.

This devotion has received new emphasis in this century from the visions given to Lucy Dos Santos, oldest of the visionaries of Fatima, in her convent in Tuy, in Spain, in 1925 and 1926. In the visions, Our Lady asked for the practice of the Five First Saturdays to help make amends for the offenses committed against her heart by the blasphemies and ingratitude of men. The practice parallels the devotion of the Nine First Fridays in honor of the Sacred Heart.

On October 31, 1942, Pope Pius XII made a solemn Act of Consecration of the Church and the whole world to the Immaculate Heart.

Let us remember this devotion year-round, but particularly through the month of August.

### ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

---

**Aug. 15.** Sacred Tradition, Sacred Scripture, and the teaching authority of the Church Catholic Church (Magisterium) are three pillars of the Catholic church. The faith in the **Assumption of the Mary** into heaven is based mainly on the sacred traditions and the magisterium of the church.

Catholic church believes and teaches the following dogmas on the Blessed Mother: The Immaculate Conception, Mary as "Mother of God", the Assumption of Mary into Heaven, and Coronation of Mary as Queen of heaven.

Though the belief in the Assumption of Mary was prevalent from the early centuries after her death, it was officially declared as a dogma of the church by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950 by an Apostolic Constitution "Munificentissimus Deus." The document says: "by the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory." ## FISCAL YEAR 2020 BUDGET

### Revenue

Weekly Offertory: \$180,000

Investments: \$35,420

Other Income: \$23,950 (Fees, Fundraisers, Donations)

Total: \$239,370

### Expenditures

Payroll & Benefits: \$82,835

Supp., Rprs. & Utilities: \$53,150

Archdiocese Stewardship: \$33,085

Other Expenses: \$70,300 (Insurance, Charity, Fund Raising exp., Advertising, Travel, Background checks.)

Total: \$239,370

Note: Budget preparation began in June and involved reviewing every line item with previous years' revenues or expenditures. Adjustments were made where needed taking in account the needs of the new year. This budget has no unnecessary expenditures.

The FY2020 budget was increased by \$14,579 due to salary and benefits of a resident priest, and additional costs to prepare the rectory to function as his personal residence and to move the office to the basement.

There was a \$10,829 shortfall in the Archdiocese One Bread One Body Campaign which is owed by the parish.

Property and liability insurances increased state-wide due to the November earthquake. Spending will continue to be monitored closely by parish administration.
