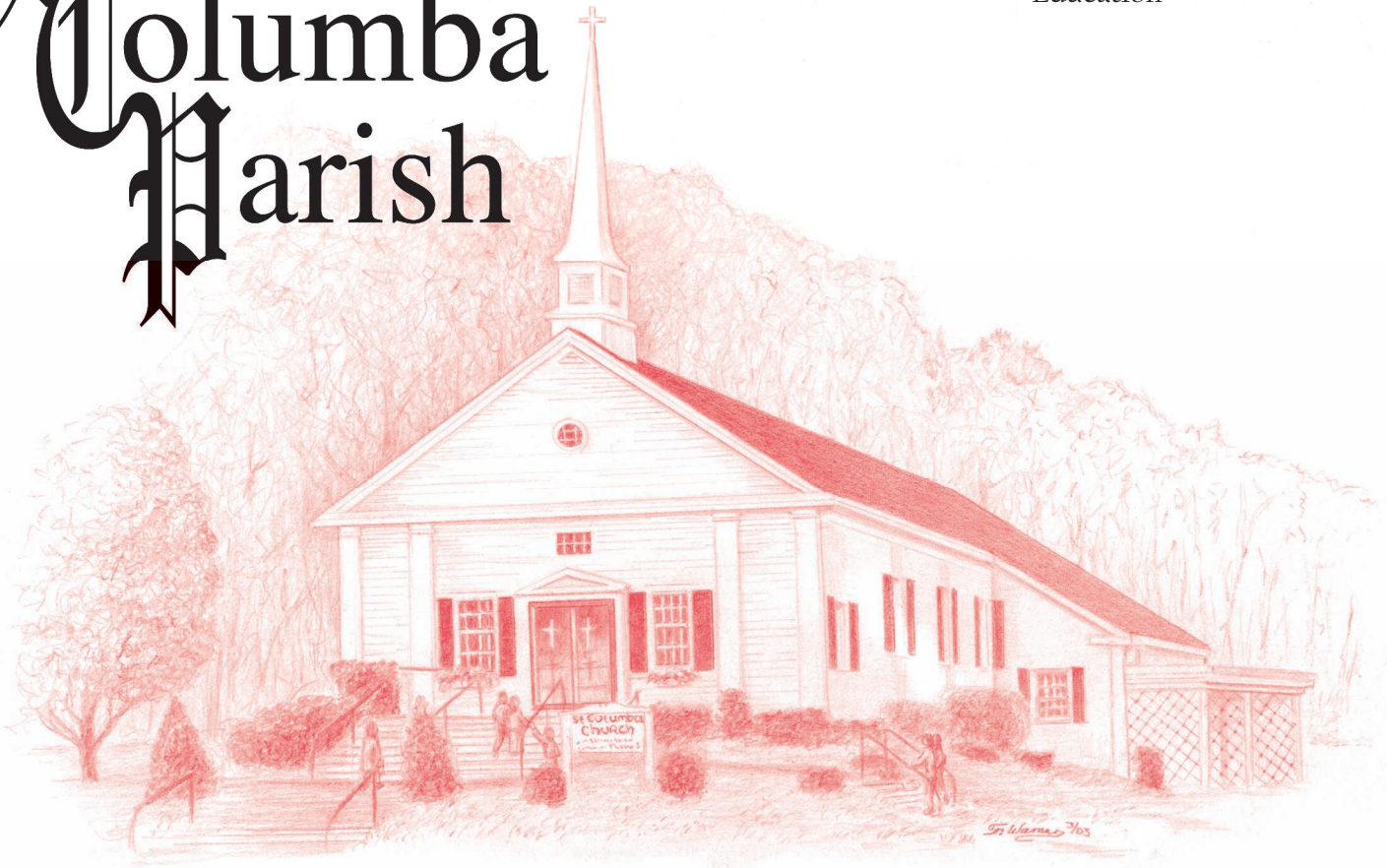

A Promise to Protect & a Pledge to Heal

We have been asked by the Bishop to remind our parishioners periodically that our parish follows the guidelines of the National Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.

The charter was approved by the U.S. Bishops and the policies of the Diocese of Worcester in screening those who work with children in our care and in helping victims of abuse find healing. If you or someone that you know has been sexually abused by a church employee or volunteer please contact the victim service coordinator for our diocese at 508-929-4363.

All volunteer fourteen (14) years and older who work or volunteer in any capacity within St. Columba must carry out the following:

1. Complete a cori form every 5 years.
2. Read the Code of Ministerial Conduct and Sign a Code of Conduct Acknowledgement form.
3. Attend a safe environment training class one time.
