

## The Rite of Christian Initiation News



### Christian Initiation of Adults: Q and A

**Q. How many are there in the RCIA at St. John's this year?**  
**A.** At this moment in time, there are **75** people in the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) process at our parish. There are 29 adults in the Inquiry and Catechumenate classes and 8 in the Adult Confirmation classes. In RCIA-Teens we have 8 in Yr. 1 and 17 in Yr. 2. In RCIA-Children we have 6 in Yr. 1 and 7 in Yr. 2 for a total of 38 children and teens.

**Q. So will 75 people receive their sacraments of initiation at the Easter Vigil this year?**

**A.** No. Remember, we now have a Year Round process, so people enter whenever the Holy Spirit moves them! The Church requires that catechumens (those who are unbaptized) remain in the period of the Catechumenate proper for **at least one year** before receiving the Sacraments of Initiation (cf. RCIA #7).

**Q. So how many will receive sacraments at the Easter Vigil this year?**

**A.** That is difficult to determine at this point because of the MANY factors involved, the most important of which is their **READINESS** to receive. There is a *possibility* that a total of 34 people will receive sacraments at the Easter Vigil in 2016: 16 adults, 11 teens, and 7 children. Six teens will receive Confirmation only at the Teen Confirmation with the Bishop in the spring *if* they are ready.

The number of other factors concerning how and when an adult receives these sacraments are too numerous to list here, but if you would like to know, you can always contact our RCIA Director at the parish office for more information!

**How do I become Catholic?**

**RCIA- The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)** is the way for adults to inquire about becoming Catholic. It is for those who have never been baptized or who have been baptized in a non-Catholic Christian tradition, as well as adult Catholics who have never received First Communion and/or Confirmation.
