- **Opening Prayer:** Sr. Maria Benedicta
- **Approval of minutes**
- **Principal Report** (Sr. Maria Benedicta):
  - End of first quarter and report cards went home last week.
  - Parent teacher conferences went well
  - PNO this Friday, Nov. 10<sup>th</sup>
  - Student service projects to help arrange Thanksgiving baskets with MHC
- **Vice-Principal Report** (Tim Fletcher):
  - DC update: Poinsettias sale---\$20,000 in sales (students get about a third of this)
  - NCEA: conference later in April 2018---plan to send some teachers and administrators to Cincinnati for it; Apply to be recognized for excellence in Catholic identity
  - Red Apple Recognition Award: award for excellence in teaching—award to be given each quarter
  - Parish staff retreat in Tipton, IN at St. Joseph’s Academy: Place for Parish retreats. Meeting about being a disciple—working towards being a good disciple and how to evangelize to others within the church and within the community
- **PTO Report** (Sr. Maria Benedicta):
  - Fall Promotion of Scrip was a success---98 families bought scrip during the promotion
  - Chick-fil-A: \$800
  - Community care day coming up
  - St. Nicholas workshop in December (Dec. 4-8)
  - December: Wendy Potrass heading up a mom’s retreat
- **Mission Effectiveness Update:**
  - Full day Kindergarten update: Got approval to move forward with full day kindy
    - Siblings will still have their spot first
    - Hire a full time IA for Mrs. McCain and 2-half day IA’s for Mrs. Pike
    - Numbers that sign up for full day kindy drive the plan for full day kindergarten
    - Financial aid for cost: possibility for this still needs to be finalized.
    - Letter to come out in December to inform families of the plan/cost. 80% of the parish budget funds the school...this is important talking point to reason why tuition is necessary.
    - Registration to be first week in January
  - Scrip ideas:
    - Shared lots of different ideas, i.e. makers space, enrichment, sensory room, new arts enrichment

- **Technology Updates:**
  - Cub scouts want to put on STEM night for all students in the school—usually adult led activity station---possibly to occur in March
- **Uniform Provider Update (Liz):**
  - Currently contract with Reiss Brothers (RB) and they are primary uniform provider
  - Lands End is one alternate option:
    - Can use scrip to purchase (16%)
    - Offer wide range of products including uniforms, spirit line, and gym uniform line
    - 30% discount with back to school prices
    - Rebates for school: RB is 5%; Lands End is 1%-5%; also get 16% scrip rebate to school
    - Lands End has easy online store, one-stop for all uniform needs, sales throughout year
    - RB: physical store to try things on in store
  - Explore school logo
