



In answer to his prayers, the Blue Fairy grants Geppetto's wish by bringing one of his wooden puppet creations to life. Naming him "Pinocchio," (Italian for "Eye of the Pine"), Geppetto tries to teach his wooden son how to be a good boy so he may become a real, flesh and blood child, but Pinocchio does not learn his lesson easily, causing great trouble in the village, skipping school, being kidnapped by a greedy puppet master,

cheated out of his father's money by the sly Fox, Cat and their animal friends, running away to a mysterious land where children are promised nothing but toys and candy but are instead turned into donkeys and forced to work all day, and enduring a thrilling chase by a monster shark! By saving his father's life, however, with the help of the Blue Fairy and his cricket friends, Pinocchio manages to mend his ways and become a kind, caring, thoughtful, compassionate...and a real, flesh and blood boy. This play includes great roles and significant stage time for everyone!

### **GIRLS' VOLLEYBALL TEAM**

Last spring we turned our clinics into a volleyball team for Sacred Heart. The season was a success for the girls, appearing in the playoffs and winning their first two rounds before losing to the eventual league champions.

This season we look to have two teams: A Varsity comprised of 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Graders and one Junior Varsity comprised of students from grades 5 and 6. Practice days will be Thursdays at the start of the season with game matches versus other schools starting in March. Our schedule will be flexible to work with other school and after school activity schedules.

The girls will continue to learn basic volleyball skills and develop a more advanced knowledge of the game. They will learn to work as a team, sportsmanship and skills.
