items, in the classrooms, school office, and parish office. This a great opportunity to help those in need in our community.

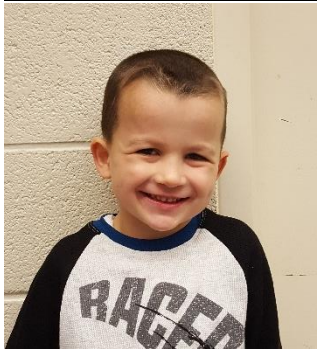
