<b>GLORY TO GOD</b> <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	<b>Gloria</b> <b>BB 9-1-1</b>		Immediately following the Penitential Right.
<b>RESPONSORIAL PSALM</b>	<b>BB pg 97</b> <b>R &amp; A pg 92</b>		<b>Cantor</b> will announce immediately following the 1 <sup>st</sup> reading
<b>GOSPEL ACCLAMATION</b>	<b>Alleluia! Give The Glory</b> <b>BB 8-8-6</b>		Following the 2 <sup>nd</sup> reading - start the Gospel acclamation when the Priest stands and says – “let us rise for the gospel”.
<b>PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS</b>	<b>All is Well With My Soul</b> <b>BB 4-7-1</b> CP NA		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
<b>HOLY, HOLY</b> <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	<b>BB 9-1-4</b>		When Father says: “... <b><i>with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim...</i></b> ” (or something similar)
<b>MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION</b> <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	<b>We Proclaim Your Death</b> <b>BB 9-1-5</b>		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ <b><i>The mystery of faith:</i></b> ”
<b>AMEN</b> <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	<b>BB 9-1-8</b>		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ <b><i>Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever:</i></b> ”
<b>LAMB OF GOD</b> <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	<b>BB 9-1-9</b>		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
<b>COMMUNION 1</b>	<b>Litany of Peace</b> <b>BB 5-2-7</b> CP NA		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
<b>COMMUNION 2</b>	<b>How Great Thou Art</b> <b>BB 4-2-4</b> CP 413		Immediately following the 1 <sup>st</sup> communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
<b>CLOSING</b>	<b>God of Our Fathers</b> <b>BB 6-2-8</b> CP 571		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
