PREPARATION OF THE GIFTS	Tis the Gift to Be Simple BB 5-1-8		Follows the prayers of the faithful read by the Lector with a short prayer by the priest.
HOLY, HOLY <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-1-4		When Father says: “... with the choirs of heaven, we cry out to your majesty on earth and without end we acclaim... ” (or something similar)
MEMORIAL ACCLAMATION <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	We Proclaim Your Death BB 9-1-5		Father will genuflect after raising the cup and say: “ The mystery of faith: ”
AMEN <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-1-8		Father will raise the cup and sing: “ Through Him with Him, and in Him, O God, almighty Father, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all glory and honor is yours, for ever and ever: ”
LAMB OF GOD <i>Mass of Christ the Savior</i>	BB 9-1-9		Immediately following the “Sign of Peace”
COMMUNION 1	The Eyes and Hands of Christ BB 5-1-7		Start as soon as the cantor and accompanist are back from communion.
COMMUNION 2	Here I Am, Lord BB 3-7-8		Immediately following the 1 st communion hymn if needed. Plan to wrap up as Father sits following communion.
CLOSING	Battle Hymn of the Republic BB 5-7-7		Priest will give the final blessing. Cantor will announce the closing hymn.
