

## How Your G.P.A. is Determined

Each quarter the N.J.H.S. moderators will check to make sure that your G.P.A. is a 93.5 or higher.

If your G.P.A. is below a 93.5, you will be placed on probation. You will then have the next quarter to bring your G.P.A. back up to a 93.5. If you fail to do so, you will be dismissed from N.J.H.S. Once dismissed, you may never become a member of N.J.H.S. again. (Note: When you are in high school, you may still be invited to join N.H.S.)

Here is how your G.P.A. will be calculated each quarter: (Add the following grades & divide by 7.)

Science grade

Math grade

English grade

Reading grade

Social Studies grade

Religion grade

Activity grade (Data Skills, P.E., Computer, Spanish or Art)
