Getting Started with IXL

IXL is an online practice program that we used to reinforce the curriculum this school year. The program allowed us to individualize the learning experience for students so that they could work at their own pace to master the material we covered through classwork and homework assignments.

Your child can sign in from home by visiting <https://www.ixl.com/signin/oll> on any computer and entering the username and password provided by the school. There are even iPad and Android apps to allow your child to practice on the go!

After you log in to your account you can click on a tab called Math located under the Learning tab. You will then find the many skills and strands your child can work on for each grade level. Click on any skill to get started practicing!

Monitoring Progress

When signed in to your child's account, a number of progress reports will be available to you under the Analytics tab, including the following that we recommend:

Progress and Improvement tab: View all of the skills your child has practiced, and the progress he or she has made.

Trouble Spots: View just the question types that your child is struggling with so that you can provide targeted help at home.
