My dear parish family:

We are fortunate to have a very strong Finance Council. I appreciate their dedication. This weekend, representatives of Bethlehem Handicrafts are here to present and sell their beautiful handmade olive wood religious articles. Please stop by their tables and you will marvel at the exquisite workmanship of the articles. Also, the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be administered at Sunday's Noon Mass. This sacrament is so beneficial to those whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age. While it does not normally bring about a physical healing, it does strengthen the sick person spiritually and/or emotionally.

In last week's bulletin, Sr. Joanne wrote about the many ministries that we have here at Sacred Heart and mentioned that we need additional Lectors and Eucharistic Ministers, particularly for certain Masses. Please consider volunteering. In addition, we also need more Ushers, especially for the 5:00, 10:00 and 6:30 Masses as well as Altar Servers for all Masses. Cardinal Tobin recently announced the establishment of a new Legatus chapter here in the Archdiocese of Newark. Legatus (www.legatus.org) is an organization of Catholic business executives and their spouses. Its mission is to study, live and spread the Faith. It strives to help members, alongside their fellow Catholic business leaders, learn practical ways of integrating their Faith with their professional and family lives. Legatus is unique in that it does not raise funds or promote projects. If you are interested in becoming part of this new lay ministry in our Archdiocese, please let me know.

When a bishop reaches the age of seventy-five, he is required, by canon law, to submit his resignation to the Pope for retirement purposes. However, his retirement doesn't become effective until the resignation is accepted by the Pope. Pope Francis recently accepted Bishop Flesey's resignation. Retired bishops still retain the authority that comes with the office of bishop, such as being able to administer the Sacrament of Confirmation. However, they are relieved of the administrative duties that the office requires. A replacement for Bishop Flesey has not been named yet.
