Cor ad cor loquitur...

(A heart-to-heart dialogue...)

My dear parish family:



Two weeks ago, our parish participated in the postcard campaign to ask our NJ State Representatives to support the Pain Capable Unborn Child Protection Act (A-1686/S-537) which would protect babies in the womb at 20-weeks and beyond. (This is just the first step in protecting all babies in the womb.) The campaign was a big success! Our parish alone sent 447 postcards to our elected officials! There is one more thing you can do to help protect the babies in the womb: Call your one State Senator and two Assembly Members and ask them to support the “Pain Capable” Act (A-1686/S-537). You can find their phone numbers by visiting <https://www.njleg.state.nj.us/districts/municipalities.asp>, finding your town and the associated NJ District and then selecting the associated District Number. Thank you for participating in the important life-saving project!

We recently received our first rebate from the Amazon Smile program. Although the amount received wasn't large (\$31.97), it wasn't for the full fourth quarter because we were only approved in mid-November 2018. I anticipate that the rebate for the first quarter of this year will be much larger. If you haven't already signed-up, please see our parish website for the link to do so. This is a simple and automatic way for you to support our parish, at no cost to you, every time you shop at Amazon. We do not receive any information from Amazon about the purchases you make. When you sign-up, you must select “Sacred Heart Roman Catholic Church, Haworth, NJ” before you begin shopping. Amazon Smile will remember your selection, and then every eligible purchase you make at smile.amazon.com will result in a donation.

When we purchased our new Hearing Assistance System, we were able to pay for it using funds from the We Are Living Stones account rather than the operating account. If you have difficulty hearing, please consider using our new system when you are at Mass. This system uses noise reduction technology to assist even those who wear hearing aids to hear better in a building such as a church. If you would like to use the system, please ask one of the priests or an usher for a receiver. The receivers are easy to operate. There are only two controls: the on/off switch and the volume control.

Lent begins this week. If you are tired of giving up sweets and coffee for Lent and are ready to embark on a different Lenten practice, leave your comfort zone for a day and challenge yourself physically, spiritually and personally. The archdiocese invites you to join them on a 10-mile pilgrimage of prayer through meditating upon the Stations of the Cross of our Lord's sufferings and death. Take up your cross and walk with Jesus! TEN MILES WITH JESUS! The walking Pilgrimage will take place on Sunday, March 24, 2019, beginning at 10:00 am at the Archdiocesan Shrine of St. John Paul II (St. Theresa of the Child Jesus Parish) 131 E. Edgar Rd., Linden, NJ and conclude at the Cathedral Basilica of the Sacred Heart, 89 Ridge St., Newark, NJ at approximately 5:00 pm with Mass celebrated by Bishop Manuel Cruz, Pastor of the Cathedral Basilica.
