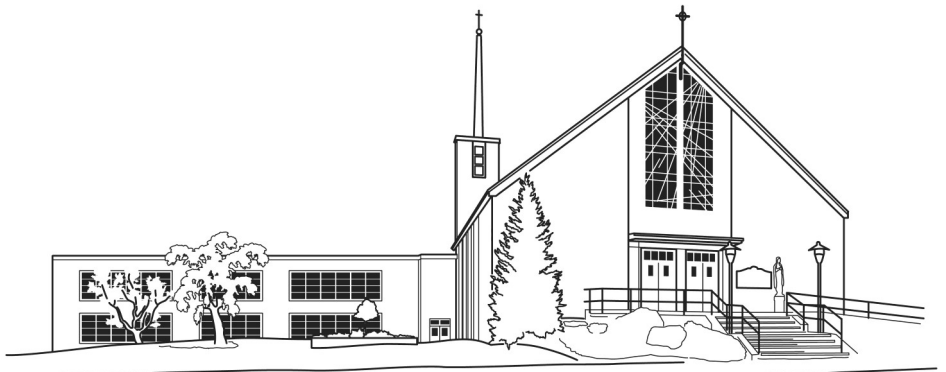

St. Mary's is proud to continue our twinning partnership with St. Michel's Parish in Roche-a-Bateau which is in the south western part of the island. Fr. Serge, the pastor of St. Michel's, continues to thank the people of St. Mary's for their generous outpouring of support following Hurricane Matthew in October of 2016.
