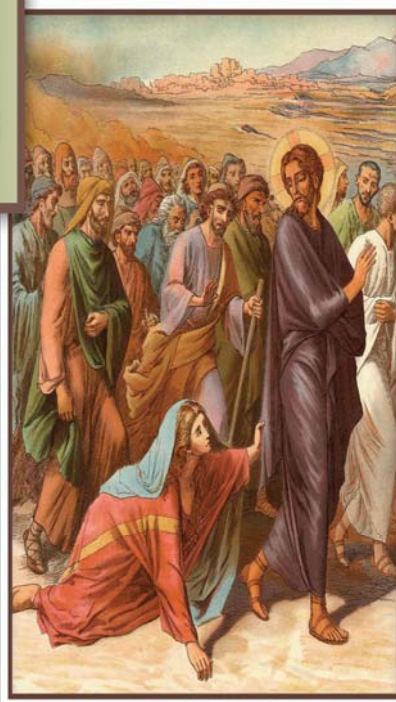

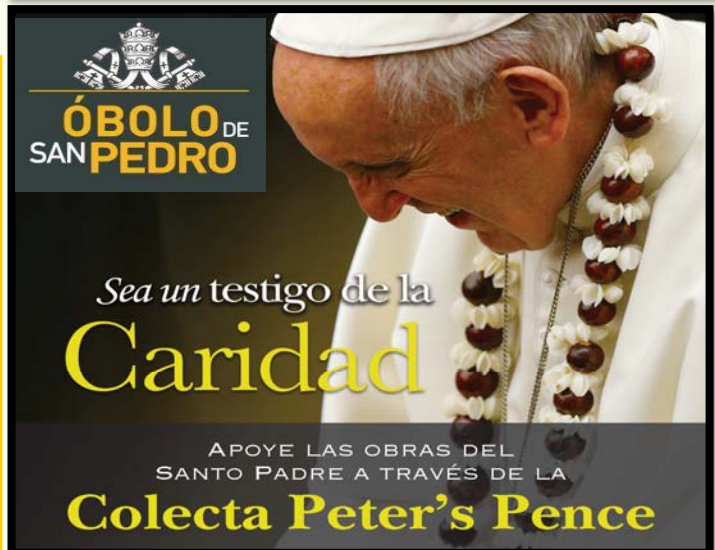
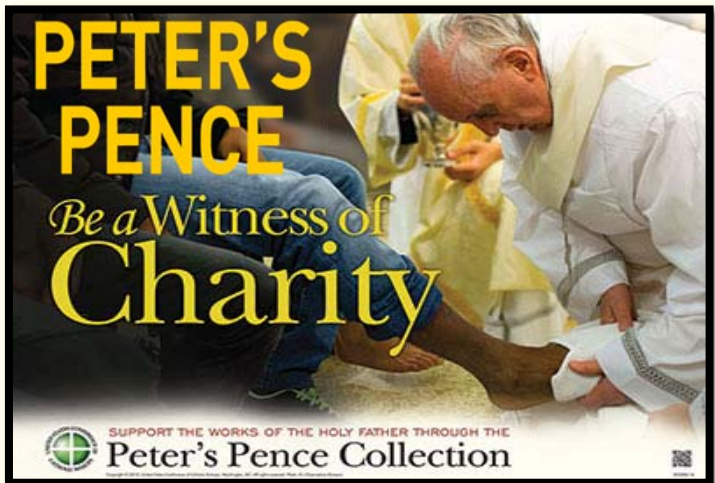

Sólo al aceptar esta duda estaremos abiertos a la invitación de Jesús: "Acerca aquí tu dedo y mira mis manos; trae tu mano y métela en mi costado, y no seas incrédulo sino creyente." Santo Tomás aceptó esta invitación y llegó a su gran proclamación de fe: "Señor mío, y Dios mío".
