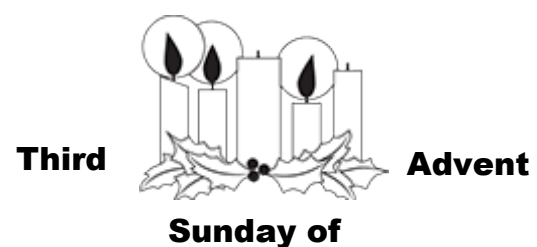

**English Pre-Baptism Class:** on the **3rd Sunday** of the month at 6PM in the small meeting room in the hall of All Hallows for parents and godparents.

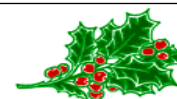
**Spanish Class** on 3rd Wednesday of the month in the church of St. Peter -All Hallows at 6:30PM for parents and godparents.

**Very Important: The Fourth Sunday of Advent AND Christmas are BOTH holy days of obligation.** Parishes that normally have Sunday night Masses are replacing them with Christmas Eve Masses. It is important to note that attending Mass on Christmas Eve does **NOT** fulfill the obligation to attend Mass on the Fourth Sunday of Advent. January 1, 2018, which is also a Monday, is a Solemnity, but **NOT** a Holy Day of Obligation.

We will meet at 6PM at the steps of the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament(11 & K) and pray for the sanctity of life as we walk to Our Lady of Guadalupe(7th & T) for Mass at 7PM.
