Bishop Jaime Soto has asked to take the following precautions to insure the health and well-being of everyone.   
\*The use of the Communion cup is suspended temporarily.  
\*Receive the Body of Christ in the hand (although receiving on the tongue is permitted)  
\*Do not shake hands. Offer the sign of Peace with those around you with a simple nod, saying "peace be with you."  
\*Do not hold hand during the Our Father.  
\*Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion are to cleanse their hands with alcohol-base antiseptic before and after administering Holy Communion. This also applies to those who take Communion to the home-bound.

The obligation to attend Mass on Sunday and other Holy Days does not apply to those who are sick.  
**If you are sick, stay home and take care of yourself.** Thank you for your patience and understanding during this time. And pray for those who are sick. The administration of Holy Communion of both kinds will resume as soon as the Bishop deems it safe and prudent to do so.
