On January 9, 2018, a federal court ruled that while a lawsuit decides whether the termination of **DACA** was unlawful, U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services must continue to accept renewal applications. Although this is a limited window and opportunity, **DACA** recipients are being advised to seek legal assistance as soon as possible to see if they are eligible. This opportunity is only for individuals who were previously granted **DACA** and **NOT** for first time recipients.
