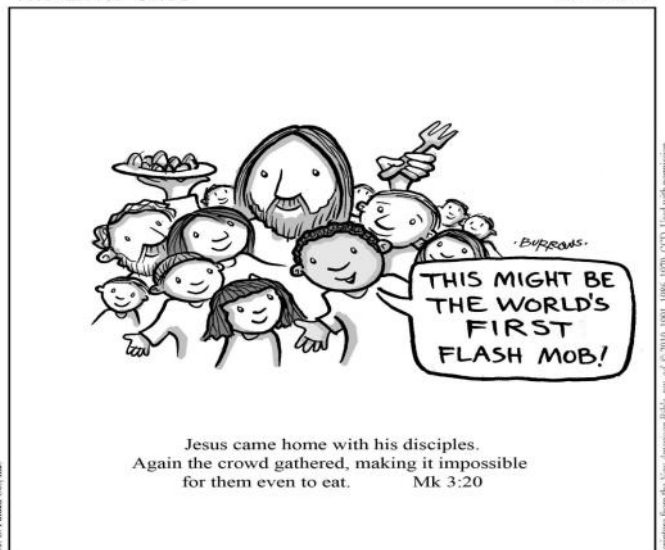


CARD CLUB:
