Divine Mercy Sunday and Novena to Divine Mercy: The Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Divine Mercy. Our Lord told St. Faustina, "On this day, the very depths of My tender Mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon souls who approach the fount of My mercy. The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." To prepare properly for this feast we should (1) Ask for God's Mercy (2) Be Merciful to Others (3) Completely Trust in Jesus. Jesus further asked that this Feast be preceded by a Novena to the Divine Mercy from Good Friday to the following Saturday. We will pray the Novena prayers and Chaplet of Divine Mercy immediately after Mass each day. Copies of the Novena are available at the back of church for use at home by families. Let us prepare ourselves to receive fully the abundant graces God wishes to give us. (Patsy Meuth)
