Twenty Second Sunday of Ordinary Time



In today's Gospel, we see a pattern in Jesus' teaching method that will be repeated in the weeks ahead. Jesus' first teaching is directed to the Pharisees who question him. Jesus' words are then directed to the crowd,

teaching that a person is defiled by his or her words and actions, not by the food that he or she eats. Jesus' words challenges us as well.

In our desire to show that we are holy, we might also give too much credence to externals, following rules without thinking about the intention behind them. Jesus reminds us that we do not make ourselves holy by our actions. Rather, we become holy when we allow God's spirit to transform us.

Our actions should be an expression of the conversion of our heart to God.

Dear God,

You have sent forth your Son

as a beacon of hope for all people.

As teacher, he has given us the

prime example of the importance

of education. As disciples, we look

to him for inspiration and strength. Thank you

for the teachers and staff who sustain our

schools today. Thank you to the parents who

education. Bless them with knowledge and

wisdom as they enter a new school year.
