Rite of Election of Catechumens – **Sunday, February 18**, the Diocese of Altoona – Johnstown will celebrate the Rite of Election of Catechumens and the Call to Continuing Conversion of Candidates at the Cathedral of the Blessed Sacrament in Altoona, beginning at 7 PM. These are men and women who are preparing to receive the Sacraments of Initiation at Easter from our parish and those in the surrounding area. The adults who are seeking Baptism will be formally named and welcomed as the Elect of God and the Candidates seeking full initiation will declare their intent and be blessed by Bishop Mark Bartchak. All parishioners are invited to join our Catechumens and Candidates and their sponsors and families in prayer and communal support. Everyone is invited to attend a light reception after in the Cathedral Hall.

In today’s first reading, Job says, “My days are swifter than a weaver’s shuttle...my life is like the wind.” The brevity of our life on earth reminds believers that there is more. Christ died and rose from the dead to share this gift with those who believe. All the prayers of the funerary rites witness to the Christian hope that life endures into eternity. At the death of a Christian, whose life of faith was begun in the waters of baptism and strengthened at the Eucharistic Table, the Church intercedes on behalf of the deceased because of its confident belief that death is not the end.
