**CATECHISM CLASS TIME CHANGE** – The regularly scheduled class for **Sunday, March 11 at 10:30 AM** has been changed to **3 PM**, so that the students will have an opportunity to listen to the presentation on the Sacred Relics. All students need to report to the Confessional in Church (by 2:45 PM) for attendance. After the presentation in the Church, we will then proceed to the upper level of the Parish Center to view and venerate the Relics. Students will be dismissed from the Parish Center. Parents are encouraged to accompany their children.



**SACRED RELICS OF THE SAINTS: TREASURES OF THE CHURCH** – Queen of Peace Church in Patton presents a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on **Sunday, March 11 at 3 PM**, in the Church. Fr. Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be here with his very special ministry to teach about these holy objects. He will bring with him over 150 relics, some as old as 2,000 yrs. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the “Little Flower”), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of *Our Lady*, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the *True Cross* in the world. The relics will be displayed in the upper level of the Parish Center. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. **In the Church’s history many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry.** Please do not miss this opportunity. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill family members / friends which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession. No food, beverages or photos permitted.
