LITURGICAL REFLECTION for the 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time, July 1, 2018

The Church has made clear statements on the practice of burying the remains of our deceased family members. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith in 2016 stated doctrinal and pastoral reasons for the preference of the burial of the remains of the faithful and to set our norms pertaining to the conservation of ashes in the case of cremation. The Church encourages conventional burial of the faithful whenever possible, (ex.) burial in a grave or mausoleum, as well as requires the appropriate reservation of the remains when cremation occurs.
