Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church – Monday, February 25 at 6 PM at Christ the King Parish (123 Good St. Houtzdale, PA). Father Carlos Martins of the Companions of the Cross will be there with a very special Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the “Little Flower”), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. In addition, there will also be present a portion of the veil of Our Lady, as well as one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. In the Church’s history, many miracles and healings have been worked in the presence of relics, and many have been healed through this ministry. Please mark your calendar. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill family/friends which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
