The Solemnity of the Epiphany

They used to call this "Little Christmas", the day we celebrate the manifestation to the representatives of the gentile world; in fact, this is "our" Christmas as the celebration of Dec. 25th was the manifestation or showing of "the church" to the Jewish world, represented by the shepherds. In my home, my mother always made sure that there was a special gift for all of us, reflecting the gifts given by the Magi to the Christ. This was not a materialistic gesture but a great show of reverence and respect for the Messiah, the one who was to be the "new" King of the Jews.

For us then, how do we translate the Magi's gesture to our own lives? How do we reverence and respect this new life? As Elizabeth Barrett Browning, the poet, wrote in the Sonnets from the Portuguese, "How do I love thee? Let me count the ways! — I love thee to the depth and breadth and height my soul can reach."

An act of kindness? Standing up for life? Putting yourself on the line? Building up your church life? Challenging those you love to do it better? and on and on and on. May 2017 be the year of more!! May it be happy, holy and healthy.

Women Doctors of the church: St. Teresa of Avila

St. Teresa of Avila lived in Spain during the Counter-Reformation. She was a mystic, reformer of the Carmelite Order and the author of several books which are an integral part of Spanish Renaissance literature as well as to Christian contemplative theory and practice. She was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Paul VI on September 27, 1970. Teresa is revered as the Doctor of Prayer. We will explore her life with the help of film clips and a movie based on her life.
