- Note: leftover items from the picnic will be brought to be used on Cemetery Sunday (water, condiments).

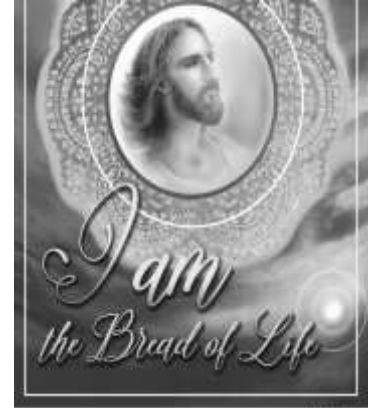
