Dear Friends,

Last Sunday, we celebrated the Ascension of the Lord. The readings reminded us all of our shared commission. "Go into the whole world proclaiming the Gospel. Paul's letter to the Ephesians reminded us of how we're to live out that job description, "with humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing one another through love, striving

to preserve the unity of the Spirit through the bonds of peace, one body and one Spirit, as you were also called to the one hope of your call." Today, on the Feast of Pentecost, our first reading from Acts of the Apostles tells us that we are given the Holy Spirit so that we can go out and fulfill our mission and proclaim the Good News!

Soon we will be closing our 160th Anniversary year. We have tried to remember and honor our past, celebrate our present, and look hopefully to the future. Soon we will be in the RENEW My Church process. What I am thinking about a lot these days is what Pope Francis calls the Church to be—a field hospital for the wounded—and how we ourselves, as part of the Body of Christ, have a role to play in healing and helping one another as we answer the call. Field hospitals aren't built according to any standard plans but are shaped by the battlefields where the wounded are found. The question we need to ask ourselves and our parish is how we are reaching out to the wounded who need our care. Our Doors are Open Wide has and should always say "All are welcomed at our field hospital". We have received the commission and received the Spirit. "We got people to heal".

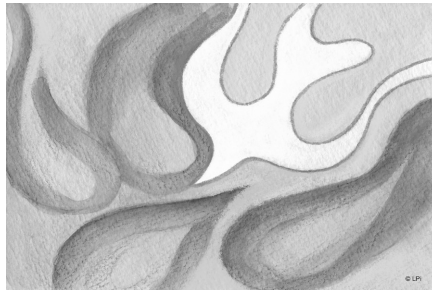

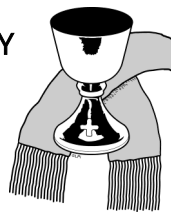
Beverly Tatum was interviewed
