At the meeting Monday night it seems that our Town officials would like to know how many people in the town would want solar panels on their property and the reason for it.

For that reason, as we assemble together in prayer, we have chosen to express to our Town officials our desire for solar panels on our property with a copy of the many signatures of our parishioners. And the reason for solar panels- one financial and another love of neighbor.

Things like diocesan needs and parish needs:

The needs are great in the Diocese of Providence because of age and the need of a new roof on our 100 years old cathedral building, and because of our changing times. For that reason a \$55 million dollar is needed.

The needs likewise are great in many of our diocesan parishes. For that reason 40% of that collected for the diocese will be returned to parishes.

Therefore, if Saint Kateri Tekakwitha would collect \$87,000 for the diocese, the amount of \$34,800 would be returned to the parish.

That same \$34,800 could be used to replace the 38 years old windows of our parish house.
