KATERI FACTS YOU MAY WANT TO KNOW!

St. Kateri Tekakwitha has three special funds:

- 1: Scholarship Fund
- 2: Jack Fay Memorial Fund
3. Women's Group Medical Emergency Fund

1: Scholarship Fund: \$500.00 is given to Freshmen College Students. If Fund increases sufficiently, we would like to extend the aid to Sophomores and maybe other years as well. Presently, we are taking part in Savers Clothing Collection. This year we are scheduled to have the Collection on Sunday, April 7th, 2019. Diane Gemma is the person who has graciously accepted to be in charge of the clothing. We hope truck and/or van owners will be able to help us transport the clothing to Savers. We presently have \$6,991.96 in the Fund.

2: Jack Fay Memorial Fund: This Fund is sustained by gifts and/or donations. These Funds are used to send 'Care Packages' at exam time and gift 'Birthday Cards' to our college students in the hope of keeping them somehow close to their parish community. Joanne Gemma has diligently seen to it that all college students who have given us their personal information have been remembered. We presently have \$8,678.58 in the Fund.

3. Women's Group Medical Emergency Fund: This Fund is sustained by the Women's Group activities; raffles, Christmas ornament sales, cook book sales, Christmas Bazaar etc.. Its purpose is to help families experiencing substantial medical bills and having problems making ends meet to obtain financial help. We presently have \$4,342.00 in the Fund.

In keeping with St Kateri's love of the ecology, we are trying to avoid all foam and plastic plates, bowls, cups and utensils. To this end we only purchase paper goods and use real utensils during parish meals. For a Take home containers we provide reusable plastic containers, If you have any you do not need we would gladly accept them. Also, when you use them, please return them to the parish so that we need not continuously purchase new ones. Thank you.
