Report:

The grand total week of November 11th was \$43,747.

Received this past week \$1,940.00. Our grand total is now **\$45,687.00**

Grateful for God's Providence Campaign:

Parishes are divided into four "blocks" over the course of 2018-2019. Each block has a target goal amount.

The 17 parishes in Block 1 had a target goal of **\$5,629,563**. Six parishes achieved their goal, four coming within 10 percent of the target and the others doing "as well as they can." The first quarterly checks — which are cut as monies are received — for those parishes were distributed at the beginning of October.

The 28 parishes in Block 2 of which Saint Kateri Tekakwitha is part of, have a target goal of just under **\$10.5 million**. Through parish receptions and presentations during Masses, parishioners are learning about the campaign's goals and how it is structured.

The Grateful for God's Providence Campaign has been established as a separate corporation. The monies raised through the Grateful for God's Providence Campaign are restricted from being reallocated to fund lawsuits, settlements or any other areas. These campaign contributions will go directly to fund the four case elements presented.
