How Often Should You Go to Confession?

While Catholics are only required to go to Confession when they are aware that they have committed a mortal sin, the Church urges the faithful to take advantage of the sacrament often. The Church strongly recommends that, in preparation for fulfilling our Easter Duty to receive Communion, we go to Confession even if we are aware of venial sin only. The Church especially urges the faithful to receive the Sacrament of Confession frequently during Lent, to help them in their spiritual preparation for Easter.

Fr. Gerald Beirne will be available for Confession on Sunday April 14th, Palm Sunday from 10:00 am to 11:00 am at Saint Kateri Tekakwitha. This is the only time during the year a visiting priest is available for Confession in our parish. A time for us to confess our sins.

FUND FOR OUR COLLEGE STUDENTS

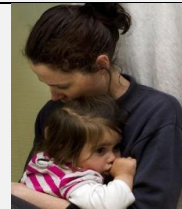
We will be collecting bags of gently used clothing after each Mass this Sunday and this week. Proceeds will benefit the Fund for the Books of our College Students.
