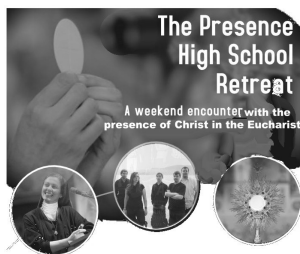

February 22-24, 2019: The Presence is an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist specifically for 9th – 12th grade high school youth that brings them to the merciful, and loving real presence of Christ. Cost for this year's retreat is \$90 per student. This year's event will take place at the Sherman Lake YMCA. Participants must attend as part of a group.

The Presence Retreat will again count as an option to complete a Confirmation retreat for those of high school age preparing to receive that sacrament. Confirmation candidates should coordinate their attendance at The Presence with their parish Director of Religious Ed.

New Year Resolution for Catholics

1. Increase Your Marian Devotion.

The way to turn back to God is the same way that God came to us— through the Blessed Mother. In 2019, commit yourself to increasing your Marian devotion so that she may lead you to deeper conversion, to follow God's will for your life more perfectly, and to increase your faith and trust in Jesus Christ.

2. Make more time for spiritual reading.

If you want to make progress in your walk with God in 2019, spiritual reading should be high on your list. If you struggle with finding the time to read, make a list of books that you'd like to complete in 2019 and pray that God will show you how you can find the time to read them.

3. Make good stewardship a lifestyle.

Practicing good stewardship over the gifts God has given us. This means good management of our "time, talent, and treasure" for the greater glory of God. Prayerfully evaluate how you will spend your time, your talents, and your income in 2019 to see what lifestyle changes you can make that will positively impact your spiritual life.

4. Share your Catholic faith with others.

Just focus on doing simple things like being joyful in your walk with Christ or inviting people to come to Mass with you. Another good idea is to buy some sacramentals, get them blessed, and hand them out to people as the Holy Spirit leads. (Rosaries, medals, Holy Cards etc.)

5. Bring back regular penances.

What penitential practice can you do each Friday in 2019? Maybe it is abstinence from meat, TV or perhaps another penitential practice such as praying the Stations of the Cross, or even acts of service for the less fortunate.

6. Go an extra day to Mass.

For 2019 think of ways you can arrange your schedule and activities so that you can make it to Mass either an extra day each week, or a few extra days a month.

7. Pray the rosary.

No Catholic list of New Year's resolutions would be complete without a daily rosary added in. If you already pray the rosary daily, that is fantastic. Your resolution can then be to spread devotion to the rosary in 2019.

8. Pick a new saint buddy.

Choose a patron saint whose virtues you would like to emulate in New Year, and entrust your year to their special intercession.
