The scriptures use so many images to teach us, form us, and lead us. Consider for a moment...the potter shapes an object, maybe your coffee mug, a vase to hold a spring flower, or even ourselves. Father). Soon trees will begin to bud, and the care we give them now, pruning, trimming, fertilizing, will produce long awaited fruit.
