Capital Improvements of Parish - AC in the Colonnade is being repaired \$47,000 the funds were available and work has begun. The Youth Center flooring and re-pointing and repainting is being estimated. A repaving of the parking lot at \$80,000 estimated is being evaluated and end estimates will be considered. The AC over sanctuary can be repaired and is being estimated.
