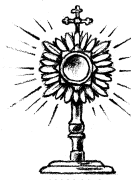

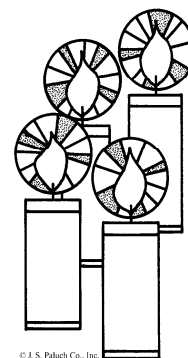
Won't you please consider becoming a scheduled adorer? All hours are available, but these hours are in need of dedicated adorers:

For children who rely on school meals to provide over 50 percent of their daily calories, summer vacation can mean not knowing where their next meal is coming from. **The SFSP, known as Summer Eats in Massachusetts**, helps to fill the void by providing meals during the summer months.

The Summer Food Service Program, known as Summer Eats in Massachusetts, is a federally-funded nutrition program that provides free meals to children ages 18 and under when school is not in session. In Massachusetts, the program is administered by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education with support from the Child Nutrition Outreach Program at Project Bread.
