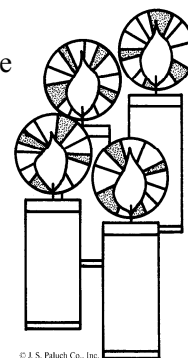

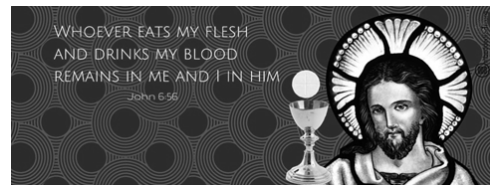


BERNADETTE CIRCLE NO. 709 UPCOMING TRIPS

OPENING THE WORD PEER RECOVERY CENTER**10 MECHANIC STREET****WEBSTER, MA 01570**

OTWPRC is a facility operated by the Church of the Reconciliation as an outreach ministry focused on supporting the recovery of individuals who suffer from substance abuse disorder. The facility is open to the public and there is no fee required to obtain services. Though we are a Christian-based ministry, we accept and encourage people of all faiths to use our center. OTWRC is staffed by volunteers, and **the range of services includes, peer recovery coaching, spiritual direction, all-recovery meetings, recovery Bible study, mentoring, and women's support groups.** Counseling, medical care, psychiatric services, medication assisted treatment, needle exchange and drug screening are NOT provided.

OTWPRC is staffed by volunteer peer recovery coaches, clergy, and mentors in recovery, and functions in collaboration with the Town of Webster Opioid Task Force.

Hours of operation are as follows:

For peer recovery coaching— Wednesday 8:30 a.m.-11:00 a.m. for walk-ins; Fridays 8:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. by appointment and Saturday 9:00 a.m. to noon by appointment. (Individuals are encouraged make appointments with the coaches to avoid having to wait, but walk-ins are also welcome.)

For Recovery Bible Study—Tuesday evenings 7:00-8:00 pm

For All Recovery meeting—Mondays 2:00-3:00 pm

For Women's support groups—TBD

For Spiritual Direction—by appointment with Rev. Ford

Our peer recovery coaching sessions are available in Spanish as well as English.
