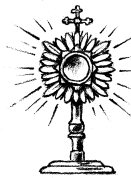

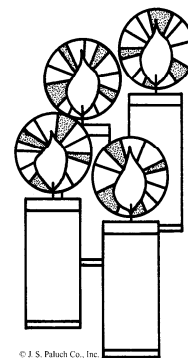

After careful consideration of the survey conducted in the parish, the Parish Council recommended, and I concurred, on the following:

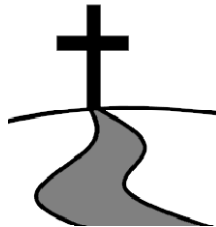
The Mass schedule for Christmas will remain the same with one exception.
