**FROM THE BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL**

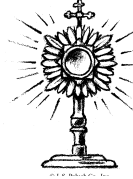

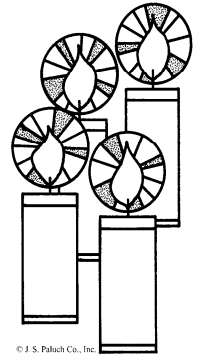

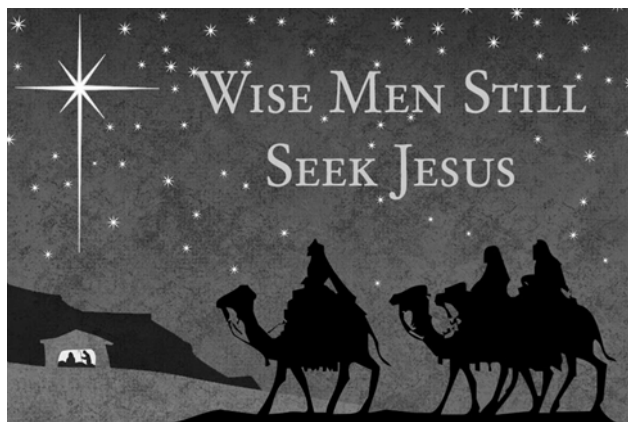
VOLUNTEER NEEDED
