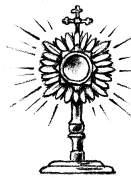
FROM THE BLESSED SACRAMENT CHAPEL

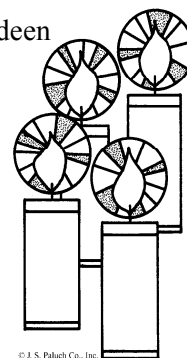
