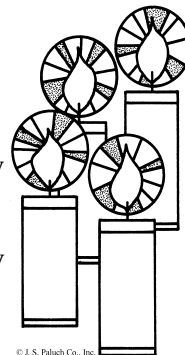

By the passion and death of Jesus, an ocean of mercy is made available for all of us. It is up to us to turn from our sinfulness and ask for His mercy not only for ourselves but for the entire world.
